














Key differences between LAC and ELAC requirements & policies

All students entering Eastern Fall 2024 will enter under ELAC requirements. This includes first- years, transfers, and re-admits. Current students will keep LAC requirements allowing the curriculum to be phased out. During this transition, advisors will be working with students who are held to LAC requirements as well as students who are held to ELAC requirements.
